Operating out of California, they engineered a revolutionary Single In-Line Memory Module (SIMM) that utilized legacy, readily available through-hole components to meet urgent market demand.

Over the past four decades, Kingston has evolved from a single-product memory module startup into a multi-billion-dollar global semiconductor powerhouse. Today, Kingston is universally recognized as the world's leading independent manufacturer of memory modules, DRAM, solid-state drives (SSDs), and USB flash pen drives.

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Did You Know? The company name "Kingston" was inspired by the popular music group *The Kingston Trio*, reflecting founder John Tu's personal love for music.

2. Timeline of USB Flash Drive & Flash Memory Milestones

As personal computing moved away from legacy optical CDs and floppy disks in the early 2000s, Kingston positioned itself at the forefront of the portable NAND flash storage revolution:

- **2002 — The Launch of DataTraveler®:** Kingston launched its trademark line of *DataTraveler®* portable USB flash drives, which quickly became the standard for portable storage across personal and commercial computing.
- **2008 — High-Speed USB 3.0:** Transitioned controller architecture to high-speed USB 3.0 standards, dramatically cutting transfer times for large digital media files.
- **2013 — The World's First 1 Terabyte Drive:** Unveiled the *DataTraveler HyperX Predator 1TB*, the world's largest capacity USB flash drive at the time.

- **2017 — Breakthrough 2 Terabyte Capacity:** Released the *DataTraveler Ultimate GT 2TB*, doubling portable USB storage limits once again.

- **2021–2026 — Gen 2 High-Speed & USB-C Integration:** Rolled out high-performance USB 3.2 Gen 2 architectures delivering speeds up to 1,000 MB/s along with native dual-connector (Type-A and Type-C) pen drives.

1. **VISUAL Phantom Color-Shift Label:** Original packaging features dynamic security labels that shift colors (e.g., green to magenta) when tilted under direct light.
2. **LASER MARKING Connector Etching:** Genuine Kingston USB drives have the capacity, model number, and country of origin directly laser-etched onto the metal USB plug casing.
3. **WARRANTY 5-Year Limited Warranty:** Original DataTraveler drives carry Kingston's official 5-year warranty backed by global service centers.
